Cecil Ray Brown was born to Cecil Ramsey Brown and Mildred Esther Cross on March 21, 1952 in Oklahoma City, OK. He passed away on February 27, 2025 at his home in Talihina, OK at the age of 72. He was one of 10 siblings who with their parents settled in Yanush, OK in 1960. As an adult, he met and married Jeannette Leanna Ward with daughter, DeeDee in 1973. Shortly after, he joined the Army and was soon appointed to the elite "Joint Communications Support Element" in Tampa, FL. His time with the JCSE was among his life's proudest accomplishments.
