Eugene "Gene" Johnico Jr., 75, passed away Saturday, August 12, 2023. Gene was born to Eugene Johnico Sr. and Walsie Mae Keck, in Talihina Oklahoma on November 6, 1947.

Gene is survived by his children; Eugene Francisco, Felicia Ann, Melody Ann, and Adrian Talley Johnico. He is also survived by 3 daughter-in-laws; Jessie, Deborah and Lesley as well as his precious niece, JoAnn Zucker and grandchildren Nikolas, Carson, Christian, Matthew, Maggie, Jett and Aidan Johnico. Gene was a talented athlete who excelled in baseball and played semi-pro baseball in California. Gene was away from his immediate family until he was 68 years old and finally was able to move to Texas on November 11, 2014 to be cared for by his twin daughters. Gene fought his battle with cancer for 8 long years. Despite spending much of his time in and out of the hospital, he never lost his sense of humor, wit and passion for all the things he loved to do like playing pool, playing poker with Melody, watching his favorite sports teams: LA Rams and Dodgers, and his beloved OU Sooners! He formed many treasured friendships within his pool hall community and was known to his friends as "Choctaw" and had the reputation of the best pool shark player around. He had a great ability to make others laugh and smile with his sarcastic humor.

Gene was so proud to be an Oklahoma Choctaw and loved reading and sharing facts on Native American history, culture and native people represented on national and international stages. He was also a sports enthusiast and could relay news, facts and opinions on a variety of sport topics. Gene took pride in his knowledge of "all things" and loved to debate or challenge you with his wisdom. Gene gave us the gift of the Johnico name and he loved to brag to his friends about his children and grandchildren and all their accomplishments that were honoring the Johnico name. Gene was never the world's

greatest Father or Grandpa but he was the PROUDEST.
