Leon Wendell Warren, age 81 of Tuskahoma, Oklahoma passed away from this life on December 21st, 2022. He was born in Honobia, Oklahoma to Mary Viola (Hinds) and Florence Edward Warren on December 19th, 1941. Leon enlisted in the U.S. Navy out of high school, and served on the USS George Clymer. While in the Navy, he met his first wife, Susan, while in port in San Diego, CA. When his tour was over, he and Susan married and relocated to Eureka, CA. They had two sons, James (deceased) and John. He worked for the US Postal Service and then owned and operated "Grace's", a neighborhood bar and pizzeria. Later he married Louise and went to work for the Pacific Lumber Company in Scotia, CA. He then entered the beef cattle business and began raising Hereford cattle. He divorced Louise and moved to Idabel, OK to continue his cattle business. Leon married his best friend, Delores "Kitty" Marie Warren and moved to Talihina, acquiring and running a variety of real estate interests. Kitty passed from cancer in 2022. In addition to his son, John, Leon leaves behind a number of close relatives and friends. He loved the outdoors and was always an active hunter and fisherman.
